

Cuttyhunk Ferry Travel Announcement 2021

Dear Folks, I thought I should post our Covid rules for people traveling with us for this season. We are trying our best and we are a no judgement ferry- we trust all of you equally to do the best you can under the circumstances. If you have further questions or concerns please bring them up, we will try to answer.

We are not much different than a bus, as public ferry transportation, we are unable to provide distancing as wind, weather, and crew interaction changes continually. We limit the number of passengers and use a decontaminate on the entire vessel inside and out after every trip.

The following rules will help reduce exposure.

Mask wearing is mandatory at the ferry docks on both sides, please give the crew distance when interacting with ticketing and luggage.

- 1. Mask wearing is mandatory during the entire trip across even when outside.**
- 2. No eating is permitted inside the cabin, it is an enclosed space even with the doors open.**
- 3. The bathroom that is available should have the door reopened after use to permit air flow.**
- 4. The galley will remain closed.**

Remember that Covid is not the only safety issue on the boat - please listen to the safety announcements carefully.

Although we might take the temperature of passengers, we have no idea if you have known or unknown symptoms. Toward that end, we are assuming, as should you, that we are all equally able to transmit and are equally vulnerable to this contagion. Thus, the precautions above.
